Lightning Detection System

Huntley Park District has a lightning warning system at Stingray Bay/Deicke Park, Tomaso Sports Park, and the Public Works Soccer Fields. This system warns of actual lightning strikes within a 10-mile radius of the park. When lightning is detected, you will hear a 15-second blast and strobe lights will begin to flash on the unit at the park. When this occurs, ALL outdoor activities should cease, and all persons should seek shelter in a permanent building or vehicle immediately. Activities may only be resumed once the system has indicated the “all clear” with three – 5 second horn blasts and the strobe lights will stop flashing. There is a minimum period of 30 minutes if the system goes into alarm before it will be all clear.

Visible Lightning: If an LDS is not present or not reporting at your field of play, suspend activity immediately after lighting is spotted or thunder is heard by ANY adult/player. Play may resume after a 30-minute period has elapsed and no additional lighting has been observed. If additional lighting is sited, 30 minutes must pass again from that moment lightning has been seen again. This repeats.



Thor Guard Lightning Prediction System and Warning System

Thor Guard is a lightening prediction system at Stingray Bay, Tomaso Sports Park and Deicke Park that warns patrons and staff of potential lightning up to a 10 mile radius. When this system detects high energy it will emit a 15 second blast and strobe lights will begin to flash. All outdoor activities should cease and all persons should seek shelter in a permanent building or vehicle immediately. **DO NOT SEEK SHELTER WITHIN DUGOUTS, PICNIC PAVILIONS, OR NEAR TALL OBJECTS SUCH AS FENCES, TREES, ETC.** The strobe light on the system will continue to flash while there is potential for a lightning strike. Activities should not be resumed until the system has indicated the “all clear” with three – 5 second horn blasts and the strobe lights stop flashing.
