

What Happens Now That I Have Registered?

First...*thank you* for registering with Huntley Little League! We are working hard to make sure you have the best possible experience during the season.

Here is some important information to keep in mind:

1) Player Evaluations

- a. You will be contacted using the email address you provided during the registration process regarding player evaluations. In 2017 these evaluations will be held on March 4 and March 5, 2017. All player evaluations are held at Players Choice Academy in Algonquin.
- b. Player evaluations are held for all players registered in all softball Divisions as well as the following baseball Divisions: AA (ages 7-8), AAA (ages 9-10) and Intermediate 50/70 (ages 11-13). Player evaluations are **NOT** held for Single A Baseball (ages 5-6), Juniors baseball (ages 13-14) or Seniors baseball (ages 14-16).
- c. You will be advised by email of the date and time of your player evaluation. You should receive this email approximately one week prior to the scheduled player evaluations. If you do not receive this email please check your Spam folder. If you still do not have it please contact our Player Agent at playeragent@huntleybaseball.com
- d. If your player is not required to participate in a player evaluation you will be contacted by your manager after the team drafts have been completed. You can expect to hear from your manager by mid-March.

2) Dick's Sporting Goods Day

- a. Our annual Dick's Sporting Goods Day will be held on Sunday March 19, 2017 at Dick's Sporting Goods in Algonquin. This one day opportunity provides our families with the opportunity to purchase any equipment (pants, shoes, bats, helmets, etc) at a significant discount! Also, this same discount can be used to purchase anything in the store on that day (not just baseball or softball equipment!).

3) Uniforms

- a. Huntley Little League provides each player with a hat/visor, jersey and socks. Each player must provide their own pants (must be grey in color) and shoes and glove. Players must provide their own protective equipment (i.e. cups for boys in baseball are required. Girls may elect to wear protective face masks in softball). Players can choose to also use their own bats, helmets, catchers' equipment and other items. Your manager will have these items in the team equipment bag for players who do not bring these items. Please note that you are not required to purchase these items. Many players simply choose to use their own equipment.

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4) Practices

- a. Little League International requires that practices cannot begin before March 15 each year. Since we live in Northern Illinois the weather plays a significant role on when we are able to use the fields for practices. Your manager will let you know your practice schedule.

5) Game Schedules

- a. Most game schedules are not available until late March or early April each year. Your manager will let you know as soon as these are available.

6) Season Length

- a. Generally speaking the season begins in mid-to-late April and ends in early to mid-June (depending upon the Division you play in).

7) End of season tournaments

- a. Some Divisions have end of season tournaments. Your manager will provide you with this information as it becomes available.
